Zachery Adam Heckler, white male, date of birth May 1, 1981, place of birth Albany, New York, residence 5880 West Quarles Drive, Littleton, Colorado 80128, residence telephone number (303) 978-0098, Zachery's personal telephone number (303) 978-1322, Columbine High School (CHS) student number 609951, 12th grader, employed part-time by the Great American Cookie Company, Southwest Plaza Mall, 8501 West Bowles Avenue, Littleton, Colorado 80123, work telephone number (303) 979-0400, employed approximately one and one-half months, was advised of the identity of the interviewing Agents and the nature and purpose of the interview. Heckler was interviewed in the presence of his father, Mark Heckler, and his mother, Veronica Heckler, at Zachery Heckler's residence. Heckler provided the following information:

Heckler was being interviewed based upon his alleged friendship with Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold, both identified as members of the Trenchcoat Mafia (TCM), and to his knowledge of the Columbine High School incident that occurred on April 20, 1999. Heckler had previously been interviewed by Special Agent (SA) Price, Investigator Mike Russell, and Sergeant John Hicks, on April 23, 1999. Heckler previously provided consent to seize two computer systems and a laptop computer from his residence.

Question: Did you ever see the large duffle bags in the cafeteria or anywhere on the grounds of the Columbine High School?

Response: No.

Heckler further advised that he was in the Choir Room located on the upper level adjacent to the auditorium during the time the incident at Columbine High School started.

Question: Did you see anyone carrying or in the possession of two large duffle bags, at a previous time?

Response: No.

Question: Did you see Eric Harris or Dylan Klebold either on Monday or Tuesday? What were they doing? What did they say? Were they with anyone else?

Response: Heckler stated that on Monday, April 19, 1999, he saw Dylan Klebold in the hallway sometime after second period hour between 9:20 a.m. and 9:25 a.m. on his way to Math class. Heckler stated that Dylan Klebold was with Robyn Anderson on Monday when he saw him.

Question: Did you leave anything behind in the cafeteria or anywhere else in the school?

Response: Heckler stated that he never went into the cafeteria during or following the incident. Heckler further advised that he did not leave anything behind in the school.

Heckler advised that he was not in the cafeteria prior or during the shooting incident at Columbine High School on April 20, 1999.

Question: Have you heard anything from anybody else about other suspects, bomb making, gun buying, etc.?

Response: He advised that Robyn Anderson told him several things about having knowledge in regard to the guns used in the CHS incident.

Question: How did you leave the cafeteria or the building? What were the events that made you leave?

Response: Heckler was shown a diagram of the school and provided identification of where he was, identified as the Choir Room, adjacent to the auditorium, exited from the Choir Room through the auditorium, through the north doors located on the east side of the gymnasium and headed toward the park located north of the school. Heckler stated that Mr. Leland Andres advised his class to stay calm due to an incident happening at the school. He further described his exit through the building and provided an initialed document dated May 3, 1999, with his initials "ZH".

Heckler stated that he did not see [REDACTED] following his exit from the school.

Question: Do you use the Internet? If so, what is your screen name? Do you have an ICQ (aka: ICQ/similar to a chat line) account?

Response: Yes.

Heckler advised that he previously had an ICQ account through the winter of 1997. Heckler provided a "Consent to Search" on two accounts: Devon Adams account, screen name boiregurl, password yebluar3, and also utilized an account of Chris Morris, screen name Lord Kibbz, password unknown.

Question: Do you know anybody with a double pierced eyebrow?

Response: No.

Question: Did you see or hear any unusual announcements prior to the shootings? Do you know what the "Thought of the Day" was over the Rebel News Network (RNN)?

Response: No.  
Heckler stated that his teacher, during the time the Rebel News Network airs, normally turns it off.

Question: Can you provide any further information of the members of the Trenchcoat Mafia?

Response: Heckler advised that he previously provided the information regarding the Trenchcoat Mafia to Investigator Mike Russell, Jefferson County District Attorney's Office, West Metro Task Force, at a previous time.

Heckler was cooperative during the interview and advised that he would be willing to take a polygraph examination, if necessary.

Attached to the FD-302 is a copy of CHS' diagram which is marked with his location in the Choir Room, and his exit


